- vine charcoal
- blending stumps
- white pastel

- a couple of interesting items with interesting shapes from home (still life)
- *photocopy of two of a home interior on 8.5 x 11 paper in gray scale(your own home, or a door, window or architectural shot that catches your eye)
- *photocopies in gray scale of figurative photos from your collection. (vintage photos are often fun. Please enlarge to 8.5 x 11
